Held on Saturday, 25 May, some 6,000 eager runners thronged through Sentosa to tackle what was billed as Singapore's toughest 10km race. The HomeTeamNS REAL Run™ is well-known for terrain running, giving runners a taste of sand, gravel and pavement in one setting.
