- 1. This year is the Singapore Bicentennial. What has it got to do with you, Home Team NSmen and your families?
- 2. Actually, quite a lot when we look back at history.

HomeTeam in the Bicentennial Journey

- 3. Since the 1800s, policemen and firefighters have been serving and protecting our people.
- In fact, in 1820, the Singapore Police Force (SPF) was formed, making it one of the earliest government organisations to be established on our little red dot.
- In 1888, the Singapore Fire Brigade was formed. It only became the SCDF in 1986.

- In 1949, 70 years ago, the first batch of 10 women began their police training. Today, our CID is headed by a woman. We have many outstanding women officers in the police and civil defence.
- 4. Some of us also remember the painful incidents in the past which challenged our officers to their limits, such as
- the collapse of Hotel New World in 1986,
- the hijack of Singapore Airlines SQ117 in 1991
- and more recently, the Pulau Busing oil storage tank fire.
- 5. In all three cases, our officers rose to the challenge.
- They mounted rescue operations to limit the damage.
- Even as we mourned our losses, the nation was grateful that our officers' actions ultimately saved lives.

- 6. There were also occasions the Home Team made Singaporeans proud. For example, in the hosting of the Trump-Kim Summit last year. Many Home Team NSMen served alongside regular officers to ensure safety and security.
- 7. In other words, the men and women in our police and civil defence forces have been very much a part of our journey in the last 200 years from Singapore to Singaporeans.
- You have been our everyday guardians
- As events around the world keep reminding us, we can never take safety and security for granted.
- It is a constant challenge that can only be addressed with unstinting vigilance.

- 8. Therefore, even though some things can change such as our uniforms, our equipment, our methods we must be steadfast in our commitment to keep each other safe and Singapore secure.
- This was necessary in the past.
- It remains so today and in the future.

- I'm very happy that at today's Members' extravaganza, we expect to have about 1,500 pledges.
- It's a good start but you can see we have a long way to go!

HomeTeamNS will also pledge to take care of the social and lifestyle needs of our NSmen and your families.

<u>W</u>e are constantly enhancing our clubhouse facilities and offerings, to cater to your recreational needs and help you bond with your families.

- In less than a year, members will be able to visit a new SMART clubhouse in Khatib. Highlights include a 4-storey Indoor Adventure Hub and our largest gym with state of the art equipment, an Indoor children's playground with interactive features and an eco-friendly 8-lane swimming pool.
