HomeTeamNS Debuts an Annual Peranakan Festival at T-Play Khatib

- HomeTeamNS launched an inaugural month-long Peranakan Festival at HomeTeamNS Khatib's T-Play on 27 November 2021.
- The festival is organised in conjunction with T-Play Khatib's 1st anniversary, and it aims to promote experiential learning and family bonding in a meaningful way.
- The festival will be packed with fun-filled activities ranging from craft, music appreciation to an Amazing Race and a Peranakan Fair. Every week, there's something new for families to learn about the Babas' and Nyonyas' rich history.
- The annual festival will be held from 27 November to 25 December this year.

















[SINGAPORE, 30 November 2021] — HomeTeamNS launched a Peranakan Festival on 27 November 2021 at its Peranakan-themed indoor playground, T-Play, residing in HomeTeamNS Khatib, in celebration of the facility's 1st anniversary.

The playground is a crowd favourite among children and parents, featuring interactive and experiential play elements where fun, play and learning come together to promote one's love and appreciation for culture and heritage. It has welcomed over 63,000 visitors since its launch in October 2020.

To commemorate this milestone, HomeTeamNS, together with the Ministry of Social and Family Development (MSF), invited a group of 50 foster children and their foster parents to the event launch. The children were treated to a free play session in T-Play Khatib and got their hands on to try out Peranakan tile painting as part of the festival's activities.

Ms Agnes Eu, Chief Executive of HomeTeamNS, said: "T-Play is not your usual indoor playground. It is designed to engage our children's brain development, motion coordination and through fun educational play, to inspire and encourage them to learn and appreciate our unique and diverse cultures. We are glad that many parents agree with us, and as we mark T-Play Khatib's anniversary, we would like to share this wonderful space we have curated with the foster children and their foster parents. We hope to provide a platform for them to engage and bond with each other in a meaningful way. It's also our way of giving back to society and to support family bonding in Singapore, one of our main brand values at HomeTeamNS."

About the Peranakan Festival

In collaboration with The Intan, Singapore's award-winning Peranakan Home Museum, the Peranakan Festival encapsulates all-things Peranakan with the goal to promote cultural appreciation, experiential learning, and family bonding through fun and play.















Alvin Yapp, owner of The Intan, shared that "The Peranakan Festival is an important milestone for Peranakan Culture in Singapore. It is a wonderful way to share the beauty of the Peranakan Culture in an interactive and educational way that appeals to the young and the young at heart."

The Peranakan Festival spans across a month, with exciting activities that families can look forward to.

From 28 November to 24 December, on weekdays and selected Sundays, visitors to T-Play Khatib can get hands-on experience in creating various *Peranakan crafts*, such as *Tile Painting*, *Peranakan Bakul Siah*, *Batik Painting and Manik Beading*. For the musically inclined, don't miss out *Dondang Sayang Di T-Play: A Musical Affairs* on 4 December, where you get to explore various percussion instruments to the tune of our Baba's & Nyonya's favourite tunes. These activities are free for all paying guests of T-Play Khatib.

There are also various ticketed events such as the *Peranakan Fair (11 – 12 December)* and the *T-Peranakan Race (18 – 19 December)*, where families get to learn more about the Peranakan culture through more games, crafts and even an Amazing Race.

The festival wraps up with a *Christmas Celebration in Peranakan Land* on 25 December. Come and experience Christmas Joget-Joget at T-Play and stop by for a photo opportunity at Santa's Peranakan House.

At 650 square metres, T-Play Khatib is the only Peranakan-themed indoor playground in Singapore, inspired by the pioneering spirit of early Peranakans and the vibrant colours and images the culture presents. In partnership with The Intan, Singapore's award-winning Peranakan Home Museum, HomeTeamNS was able to incorporate the rich Peranakan culture into the playground at T-Play Khatib, where parents and their children can come in to appreciate the Peranakan culture through a unique and enjoyable audio, visual and sensory experience.

The indoor children playground encourages parent-child bonding, and the structure and play elements are also specially designed to allow children to run freely. Key highlights include a















climbing slide tunnel, sport pitch, a foam ball shooting arena, an interactive trampoline, ball pit and a ninja course, all conceptualised to engage the child's brain development, motion coordination and sense of direction.

About The Intan

Founded in 2003, The Intan ("rose-cut diamond "in Malay), is a Peranakan heritage home-museum. The Intan offers personalized tours by the collector and the owner Alvin Yapp, which culminate into authentic Peranakan tea sessions and dinners inspired by his mother. The Intan also doubles as a unique event space, having hosted a variety of activities that included jewelry exhibitions, art shows and violin recitals.
