- 5. Your efforts have helped to make Singapore one of the safest and most secure countries in the world. Our citizens feel safe and trust our law enforcement agencies.
- Gallup's 2022 Law and Order Index ranked Singapore as the safest country in the world.
- Singapore also has one of the lowest fire fatality rates in the world, according to the World Fire Statistics Report released in 2022.
- 6. However, there are challenges ahead for the Home Team.

7. Safety and security threats are constantly evolving.



- Scams in various forms phishing scams, e-commerce scams, investment scams and job scams – remain a major concern.
- Methamphetamine trafficking is increasing in the region. The level of cannabis abuse among our youth has returned to preCovid levels.

Terrorism and self-radicalisation are still serious threats.

Just in December 2022 and January 2023, two selfradicalised youths aged just 15 and 16 were issued with orders under the Internal Security Act.

• We must continue to manage issues of identity along racial, religious and political lines sensitively.

Or risk serious repercussions for our social cohesion.

 Our multi-racial and multi-religious society makes us potentially vulnerable to misinformation and foreign influence campaigns.

Chat applications and social media platforms have made it easier, faster and cheaper to carry out malicious campaigns against us.

8. We need to remain vigilant against these threats, maintain high public trust and deliver on our mission.



• He constantly provides feedback and professional insights to shape HomeTeamNS's IT capabilities and is a source of motivation to the Committee and HomeTeamNS staff.


